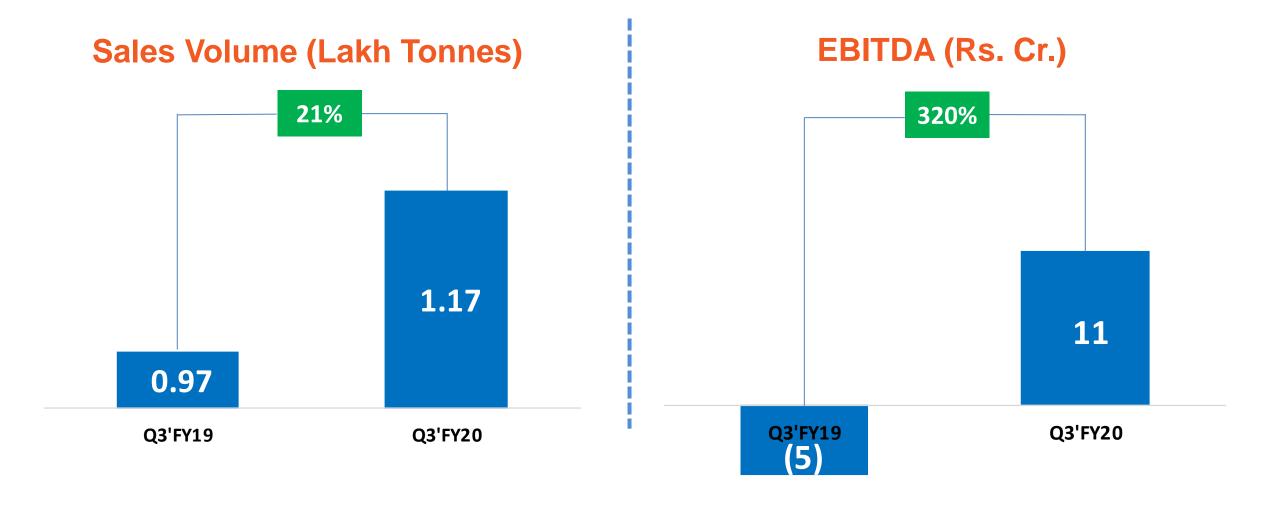

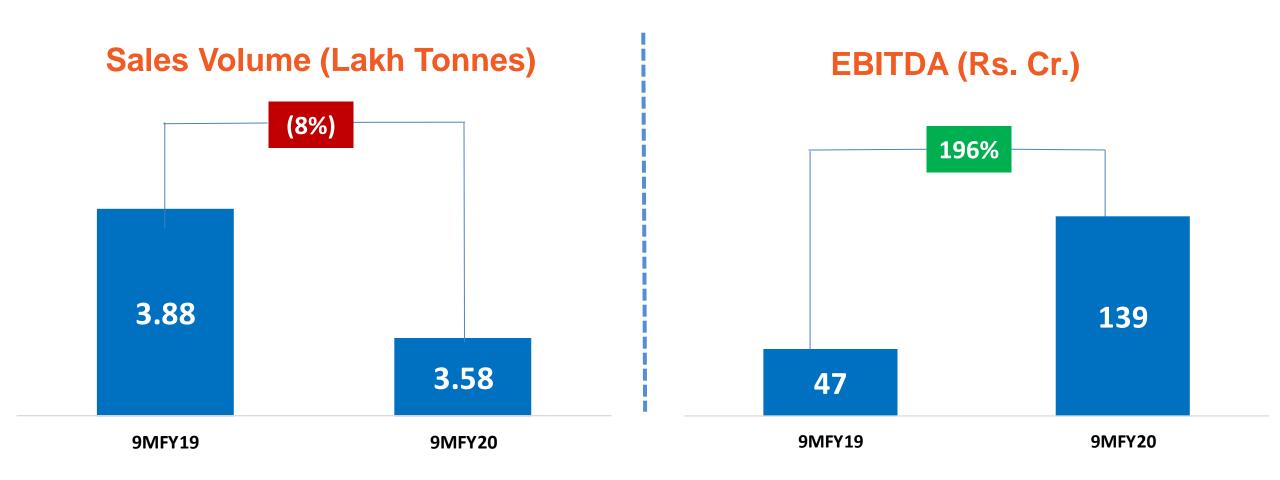
## Sugar – Q3FY20





#### Sugar – 9MFY20

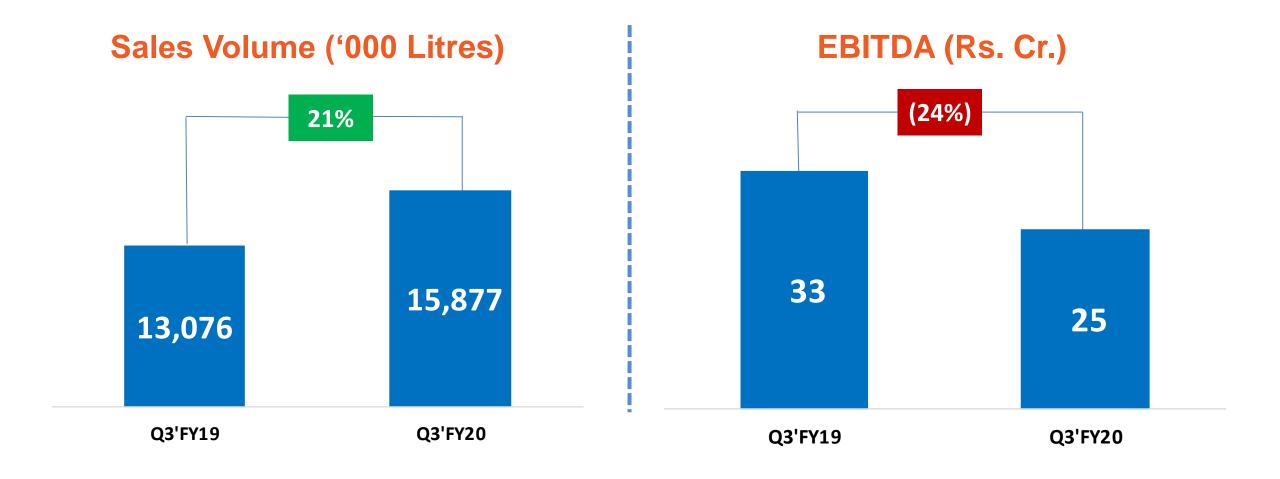

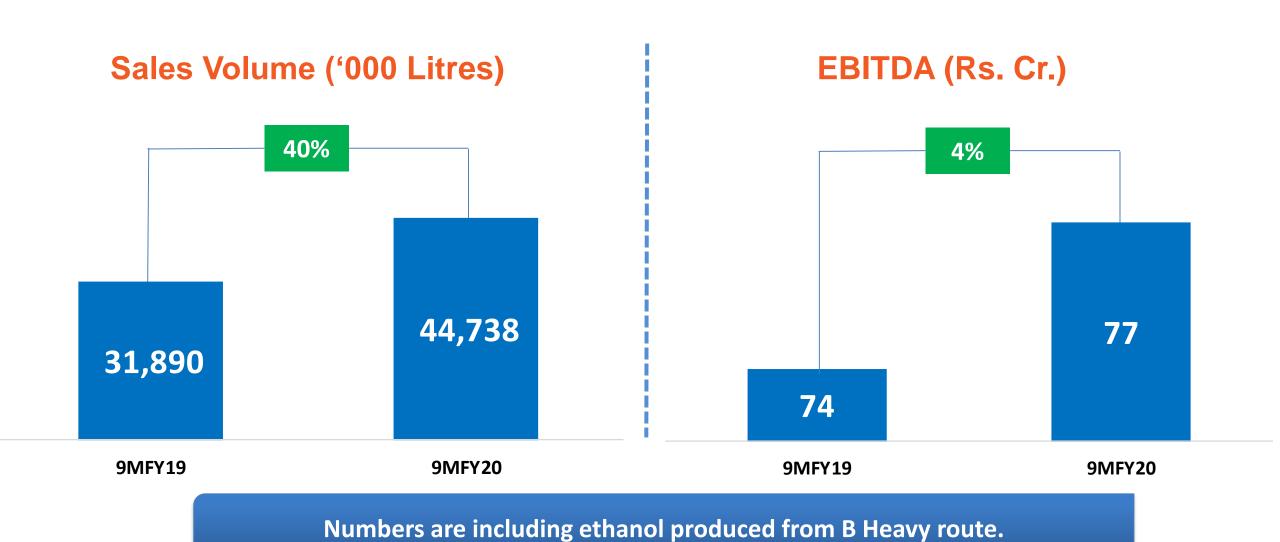

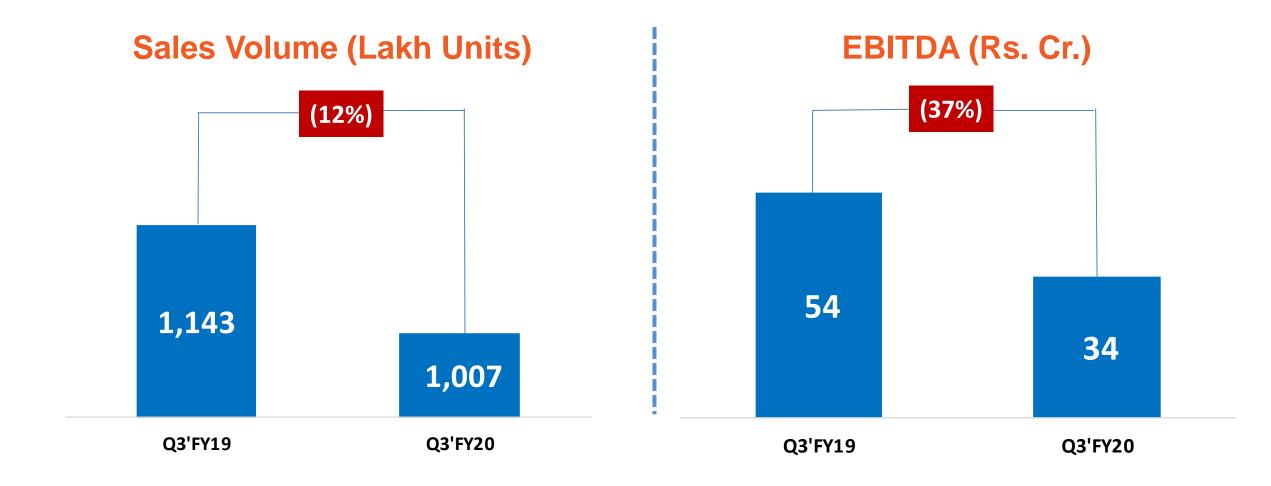
#### Distillery – 9MFY20





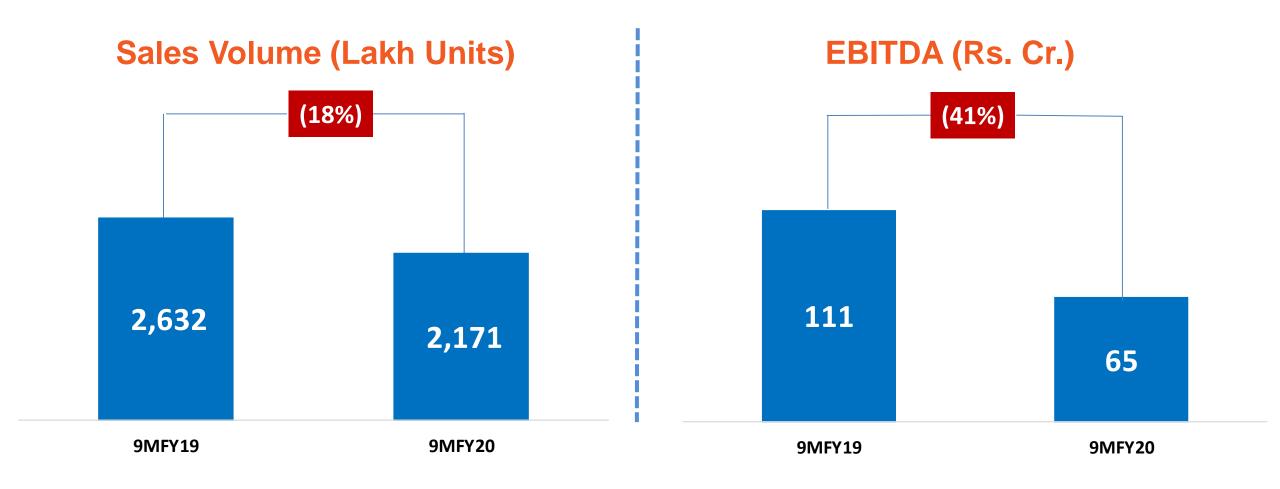
#### **Power - Q3FY20**

## Corporate Social Responsibility

#### **CSR** initiatives





Construction and rejuvenation of 12 village ponds was undertaken in the three locations of Uttar Pradesh. 13 new ponds have been identified for rejuvenation in this year. 785 saplings of different plant species being planted on the banks and bunds of the de-silted 14 village ponds in all the 3 locations in Uttar Pradesh.



Mini Grid project distributing electricity to 102 households and 119 farmers for pumping water for irrigating their lands. Revenue of INR 2.18 lakh generated from both the Mini Grids till Dec' FY20. 96 households from Jawaharpur, Nigohi and Ramgarh connected to Ujjwala Scheme.

#### **CSR** initiatives





211 trainees of 4 trades in DIKSHa Sitapur were offered placements and 180 youth are undergoing training in 4 trades. NSFDC is providing an assistance for 180 SC trainees to be trained in DIKSHa, Uttar Pradesh. A project initiated with NABSKILL, UPRO NABARD to train 120 trainees in DIKSHa Sitapur.



7 Health Camps organized in 3 locations of Uttar Pradesh and Kolhapur, Maharashtra providing free consultation and medicines to 1,785 beneficiaries. Under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, 7 new toilets have been constructed in village Kudirna and Nekpur. Drinking Water Pipeline of 550 feet and 16,500 liter Reserve water tank also installed.

#### **Industry News**



#### Lower Sugar Production in Maharashtra and Karnataka

Sugar production in the current season is estimated to decline due to significantly lower production in Maharashtra & Karnataka. However, sugar inventory in India would still remain high due to high opening stocks.

#### **Enhanced performance in the upcoming quarters**

With comparatively lower inventory overhang coupled with various initiatives of the Government such as creation of buffer stock, Export subsidy, MSP, increase in prices of B heavy ethanol etc. will lead to overall improved environment in the coming quarters.

#### **Representation to the Government**

Industry has represented to the Government the key areas for improvement of health of the industry as under:-

- Rationalization of sugarcane pricing policy.
- > To declare long term ethanol pricing formula.
- To intervene in decision of reducing cogen tariffs in UP.
- Transparency in monthly sugar sales quota.
- Adequate budgetary allocations for various subsidies and incentives.
- Increase in transport rebate for cane transportation.
- Reallocation of MAEQ to maximize exports.
- ➤ To increase FRP Base recovery from 10% to 10.5%.
