Dear Sir(s)/Madam,

This is to inform you that Dalmia Bharat Sugar and Industries Limited ("**the Company**") has received demand of export pass fees on supply of Denatured Power Alcohol, i.e., Ethanol, of Rs. 21,10,06,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Crore, Ten Lakh, Six Thousand only) from Assistant Excise Commissioner, Government of Uttar Pradesh, retrospectively, covering the period from Financial Year 2018-19 to Financial Year 2025-26.

It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned today, July 24, 2025, that the Company has challenged the said demand through UP Sugar Mills Association before the Lucknow Bench of the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court.

The disclosure in terms of Regulation 30 read with Schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 is attached and marked as **Annexure 1**.

Brief details of dispute/ litigation	The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its Order dated October 23, 2024 had upheld the State's authority to regulate the import/export of Denatured Power Alcohol/Spirits. Pursuant thereto, the Assistant Excise Commissioner, Government of Uttar Pradesh, has raised demand of export pass fees on supply of Denatured Power Alcohol, i. e., Ethanol, amounting to Rs. 21,10,06,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Crore, Ten Lakh, Six Thousand only), on Dalmia Bharat Sugar and Industries Limited, retrospectively, covering the period from Financial Year 2018-19 to Financial Year 2025-26.  After examining the aforesaid levy, the Company has challenged the said demand through UP Sugar Mills Association before Lucknow Bench of the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court.  DBSIL expects to get the said demand quashed by the Hon'ble High Court.
4.	Expected Financial implication, if any, due to compensation, penalty, etc.	There is no material impact financially, operationally or otherwise on the Company, except to the extent of
